# Qualification Outline

This qualification covers the skills and knowledge to apply substantial knowledge and skills in a wide variety of WHS contexts and industry areas.

To achieve a Diploma of Work Health and Safety, a total of **nine (9) units** of competency must be completed, including:

- **Five (5) core units, plus Four (4) elective units**

## Entry Requirements

All five (5) core units in BSB41415 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety or equivalent competencies must be completed:

- BSBWHS402 Assist with compliance with WHS laws
- BSBWHS403 Contribute to implementing and maintaining WHS consultation and participation processes
- BSBWHS404 Contribute to WHS hazard identification, risk assessment and risk control
- BSBWHS405 Contribute to implementing and maintaining WHS management systems
- BSBWHS406 Assist with responding to incidents
